

SSG Associate Representative

For SSG council, there will be two Associate representatives sharing the responsibilities listed below.

Each position will be held for 2 years. We aim for the appointments to be staggered for the continuity of duties however in the event that these terms of office are not then a comprehensive handover will be completed. This can include attendance of newly elected representatives attending meetings prior to them officially starting their role.

Ideally these roles will be appointed from different areas of Scotland to ensure good geographic representation.

Person specification

- 1. Open to all Allied Health Professionals, Specialist Nurses, Advanced Nurse Practitioners, Pharmacists and Physician Associates involved with luminal and endoscopy band 7 or above
- 2. Dedicated and organised
- 3. An active and paid up member of the SSG

Job descriptions:

- 1. Update and review training & nurse & AHP web pages on SSG website
- 2. Attend SSG council meeting x 4 per year (teleconferencing facilities are available for some meetings)
- 3. Keep communication with all nurses and allied health professionals in Scotland
 - a. Advertise opportunities
 - b. Promote SSG courses

Application Process:

To apply for one of the roles, your application must be supported by two members of the SSG and a 200 word statement must be submitted.
