

## SSG Endoscopy Representative Job Description:

## Term of office:

2 years

## Eligibility:

Active & paid up member of the Scottish Society of Gastroenterology. Nominations will be submitted in writing to the Secretary and will consist of the signed agreement of the nominee, and the signatures of a proposer and seconder drawn from the Society and a 200 word statement from the candidate. If a vote is required then this will be followed in line with the SSG constitution.

## Job outline:

The Scottish Society of Gastroenterology is an inclusive society which aims to represent and reflect gastroenterology services across Scotland, and also aims to align with services across the rest of the UK, maintaining close links to the British Society of Gastroenterology. The membership of the council is designed to give representation to all aspects of gastroenterology services across Scotland.

The candidate for endoscopy services on the council should be a clinician actively trained in endoscopy techniques, and with a sound knowledge of quality standards in endoscopy, including JAG, and ideally from a unit with JAG accreditation or active participation in gaining accreditation. Desirable qualities would include current or previous experience as endoscopy training lead, evidence of MDT working (e.g. complex polyp MDTs) and participation in quality standards work
